AVERY FFA COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

The Avery Scholarship will be confided to applicants who enroll for a minimum of twelve (12) semester hours in a college or university, and maintain a 2.0 grade point average.

ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

- 1.** Any active member of the Avery FFA Association who is a current year graduating senior is eligible to apply. The applicant must have paid dues for the current year and at least two of the three previous years. Must have completed at least six (6) semesters of agri-science and / or agri-business courses. It is mandatory that the scholarship winner attend college the fall semester immediately following selection. Only with special permission from the donor and the FFA Advisor may the use of the scholarship be deferred for one year.
- 2.** Criteria used in selecting scholarship recipients will include: (1) scholarship or academic achievement, (2) SAT or ACT scores, (3) Agricultural Science and FFA activities, (4) performance during interviews, (5) leadership outside the FFA, and (6) financial need.
- 3.** A copy of the student academic achievement record (transcript) for the first three and one-half (3 ½) years, signed by a school official (principal or counselor) and with a school seal, must accompany the application. The applicant's scholastic rank for the first three and one-half (3 ½) years of high school must be in the upper one-half (1/2) of his/her class.
- 4.** SAT or ACT tests must be taken and scores received before April 1. No exceptions will be made, and the scores will be included in the application and posted on the transcript.
- 5.** All scholarship applicants must be present in Official FFA Dress (according to FFA Manual) at all scholarship interviews.
- 6.** All scholarship application pages must be typewritten, except for signatures.
